15. NuPECC Long Range Plan 2017

15.1. Brochure

A next-to-final version has been sent to the NuPECC Members before the meeting; very last corrections can be made by October 13, 2017, then the brochure will be finalised and sent to print. It will be printed at ELI-NP and distributed together with the next issue of Nuclear Physics News

15.2. Presentation Event

A presentation event will be organised at the University Foundation in Brussels on November 27, 2017, 13 – 17 h. Invitations have been sent to all those suggested by the NuPECC Members as well as the NuPECC Members themselves and the Conveners of the Working Groups. A draft programme for the event is shown and approved. Copies of the brochure and NPN 27.3 will be available at the event.

15.3. Dissemination

The NuPECC LRP was released on the NuPECC Website on June 19, 2017; the NuPECC Members received copies that were printed at ELI-NP to distribute in particular to their funding agencies.

16. Revision Terms of Reference

Marek Lewitowicz, Jens Jørgen Gaardhøje and Paul Greenlees prepared a revised version, which was distributed to the NuPECC Members before the meeting. Marek Lewitowicz reports mainly on the changes, the new possibility of an "Associated Membership" and to appoint a Deputy Chair; his presentation can be found on the NuPECC Website. The final version will be prepared for and should be approved at the next NuPECC Meeting in Amsterdam on March 16 and 17, 2018.
